Just as we are learning to live with RoHS and WEEE, along comes REACH!

The EU Regulation on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of Chemicals, known as REACH, became law across the EU on 1 June 2007, and pre-registration is already in process (1 June - 1 Dec 2008.) AND... there is also an ongoing review of RoHS which, rather than relax the rules as we might have hoped, seems set to restrict even more substances. Plus we have Directives on Batteries and on Energy Usage (EUP) to concern ourselves with. Norway, which is not in the EU, has proposed its own, apparently more stringent, version of regulation similar to RoHS, also... but this is just Europe! China and Korea have RoHS/WEEE-like legislation in place and others will surely follow.

How do we ensure global corporate due diligence and keep up to date with all of this?

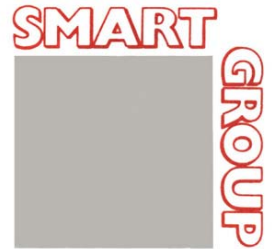

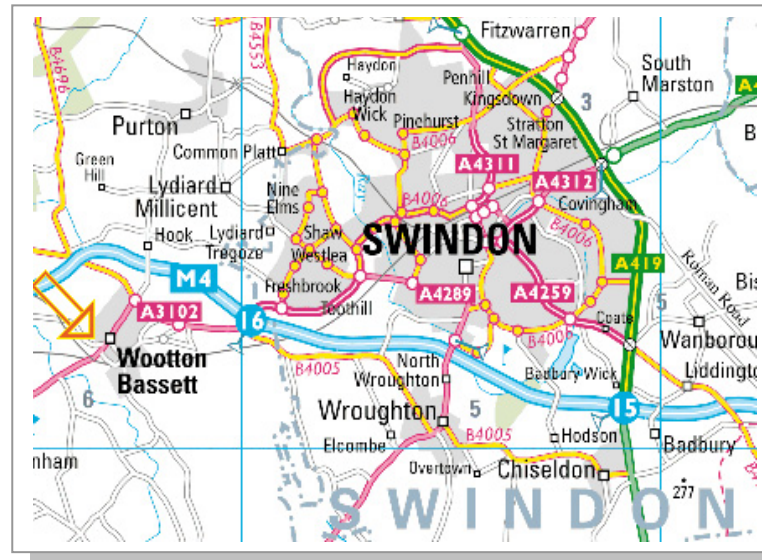


By Car from M4 Motorway
